

Let us have different questions: Are the mentioned contexts foreign to our human nature? Do they not fit the actual dreams of humankind tired of fatal problems?




VII. REVOLUTIONARY ATTITUDE TOWARDS THE INDIAN SPIRITUAL HERITAGE
